- b. **Certified Anti-Corruption Manager (CACM) management credential:** The AACI will provide the CACM and its review course to the CCEAC constituents at preferential prices.

- c. **The AACI and the CCEAC Innovative Initiatives:** The AACI and the CCEAC will work together to capitalize on the University of Ottawa Centre for Continuing Education infrastructure and the parties' market reach to design and offer innovative anti-corruption initiatives.
- d. **Develop and Deploy Cutting-Edge Anti-Corruption Programs.** The AACI and the CCEAC will work on developing highly reputable anti-corruption training programs and jointly marketing them globally.
- e. **Student Membership:** The AACI and the CCEAC will work together to promote student membership among the University of Ottawa students.
- f. **Empower Academia Students** to play a visible and effective role in preventing fraud and corruption in their local communities Launch Innovative Local Corruption Prevention Initiatives
